

**The Beijing Consensus of the Second BRICS
International Competition Conference between Competition Authorities
of the Federative Republic of Brazil, the Russian Federation,
the Republic of India, the People's Republic of China and
the Republic of South Africa
September 21, 2011, Beijing, China**

To implement *Sanya Declaration* and *Action Plan* of The Third BRICS Leaders Meeting, the Heads of the Competition Authorities of Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa jointly hold the Second BRICS International Competition Conference on September 21-22, 2011 in Beijing, China, and hold their meeting on September 21, 2011.

The Heads of the Competition Authorities of Brazil, Russia, India and China warmly welcome Competition Authority of South Africa joining the BRICS International Competition Conference. BRICS International Competition Conference is an important platform for dialogue and cooperation in competition policy between BRICS Competition Authorities, reflecting the principle of mutual trust and respect, and promoting exchange and cooperation in competition legislation and enforcement field in a pragmatic manner. BRICS International Competition Conference is organized periodically.

Addressing global financial crisis and promoting the long-term sustainable and rapid development of the economy is the common task of BRICS countries. We share the view that, reaching broad consensus among national and regional Competition Authorities and adopting effective competition policy, is of important significance to maintain fair competition, protect consumers, and promote development of market economy.


We highly concern the latest development and the enforcement result of global competition law and policy, and are willing to extensively exchange views on relevant issues and make contribution accordingly.

The Competition Authorities of Brazil, Russia, China and South Africa support the hosting of third BRICS International Competition Commission during 2013 by the Competition Commission of India.




For the Brazilian Competition Policy System
